COMPETITION RULES:

- Ensure that the people in the photo are aware that the picture has been entered in a competition. If a person is clearly recognisable we will seek a release form from the photographer for that person.
- The competition is open only to non-professional photographers
- You may enter up to 4 photographs
- Photographs must have been taken in the last year and not previously published
- The photo must clearly show volunteering in action
- The photographs must be in high-resolution jpg formats only, of a minimum of 300dpi. Please also remember to submit uncompressed digital files.
- The filename you give to the image(s) will become the display name on our image library. It is therefore very important to give images a filename that describes the content of the image.
- In accordance with national *Children First Child Protection Guidelines*, children cannot be photographed without written parental consent. Please refer to these guidelines for further clarification if photographing children.
- The organisers reserve the right to free reproduction and exhibition of all entries, with acknowledgement of the photographer where possible
- Photographs (CDs, Memory Sticks etc.) can not be returned
- A panel of judges will choose the winning and commended entries. This decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into
- The winner and runners up will be notified in early October and these photographs will be displayed during Social Inclusion Week 2010 and throughout 2011.
